





Screen shot of Tab2- For Research Application




Screen shot of Tab2 – For Course applications



IMPORTANT NOTE: Candidates who hold non-Indian passports can only apply for International Admissions (OCI card holders must check the category on the instructions page to before applying via International or Regular mode.

Categorization of OCI CANDIDATES:

Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) Cardholders, will be treated as foreign nationals for IISc admissions under the following two categories:

Category-1: OCI students who have obtained their degree/domiciled in India. The definition of domiciled in India is pertaining to qualifying degree (for M.Tech. and Research admissions, it is B.S. (4 year)/B.E./B.Tech./M.Sc.; for UG admissions, it is 10+2) obtained from India. These Category-1 students will apply through regular admission portal. There

will be no separate merit list for these Category-1 students and will be part of the general category merit list.

Category-2: OCI students with a foreign degree/domiciled in foreign location. The students should have qualifying degrees (for M.Tech. and Research admissions, it is B.S. (4 year)/B.E./B.Tech./M.Sc. or equivalent; for UG admissions, it is 10+2 or equivalent) obtained from foreign location. They will apply through the current international student admission portal. All admission rules that are prevalent for international students will be applicable to Category-2 students.
